What is EPR?

Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) is an environmental policy where a producer's obligations and responsibilities for a product are extended into the post-consumer stage of its life cycle.

Producers are responsible for an EPR fee, which is based on the products put on the market in a specific country. Introducing EPR improves infrastructure, opens investment into new technologies, as well as incentivises environmental design. The textile industry uses 93 billion cubic metres of water

What does textiles EPR mean for you?

Though there will be some variation between countries, the principles of EPR are consistent. By 1st January 2025, EU legislation will mandate the setup of schemes for the separate collection of textiles for reuse and recycling.

The European Parliament has agreed to EPR schemes, through which producers that sell textiles in the EU will cover costs for collecting, sorting and recycling them separately. Member states will have to establish these schemes 18 months after the directive comes into force.

The new rules will cover products such as clothing and accessories, blankets, bed linen, curtains, hats, footwear, mattresses, and carpets, as well as products that contain textile-related materials such as leather, composition leather, rubber or plastic.
